

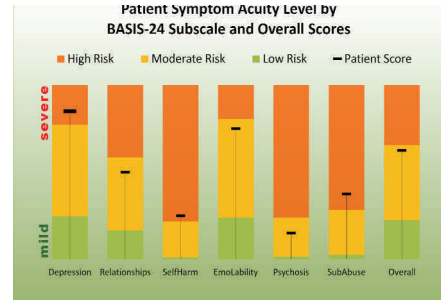

### Coming in 2016: BASIS-24 Online Reporting to Include Clinical Cut Scores

Based on newly validated normative data for BASIS-24 and the development of Clinical Cut Scores, eBASIS online case-level and aggregate reports will be enhanced in 2016 to include risk levels and national comparison group scores. McLean eBASIS will also publish a BASIS-24 Application Guide that includes comprehensive information about BASIS-24 and its use. Stay tuned for more details!

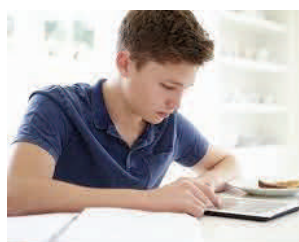
### BASIS-Teen Pilot Survey Launched!

On November 16, 2015, McLean eBASIS officially launched the BASIS-Teen Pilot Survey. Over 30 participating eBASIS client facilities will use the BASIS-Teen Survey for a one year period for adolescent age 12-18 along with 3 additional validated surveys from the patient, parent and clinician perspective.

Direct Entry of surveys via tablet, laptop or PC is available and participating

facilities will receive quarterly reports and a final report at the end of the pilot.

## HBIPS Core Measures: Collection for 3 Measures Discontinued in 2016

Starting January 1, 2016, Inpatient Psychiatric Facilities who report HBIPS Measures to The Joint Commission will no longer be required to submit Measures 4, 6 and 7 to The Joint Commission. This is a reporting change only and does not mean that the data collection and/or practices related to anti-psychotic medications and transmission of continued care plans to the next level of care should be discontinued.

Since McLean eBASIS must still collect and transmit 4Q15 HBIPS Measures to TJC, the fields for Measures 4, 6 and 7 must still be entered in eBASIS. McLean eBASIS will be polling HBIPS clients to determine their future use of the fields and any changes to the fields will be communicated to all HBIPS clients.

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### CMS Updates

#### New and Ongoing Measures

In addition to the ongoing collection of SUB-1, TOB 1 & 2, IMM-2 and structural measures, CMS will require all Inpatient Psychiatric Facilities who participate in the IPFQR program to collect SUB-2/2a and TOB 3/3a beginning with all discharges 1/1/16. Beginning 7/1/16, IPFs will also be required to begin screening for metabolic disorders and to report on timely transmission of continued care plans to the next level of care.

#### Patient Experience of Care

One of the structural measures that CMS now requires is the use of an Assessment of Patient Experience of Care. You can fulfill this requirement by subscribing to the McLean eBASIS Perceptions of Care tools. Offered in an Inpatient/Residential/Partial and Outpatient versions, the tools have 21 questions for patients to anonymously assess the level of care received.
